Garapa (Apuleia Leiocarpa) is often chosen by architects, builders, and homeowners for its attractive light golden color, its durability, fine grain, kiln-dried performance, and value. Also referred to as Brazilian Ash in the flooring trade, Garapa is known to slightly darken upon exposure to ultraviolet light. The result is a golden-brown hue color similar to teak that compliments any application.

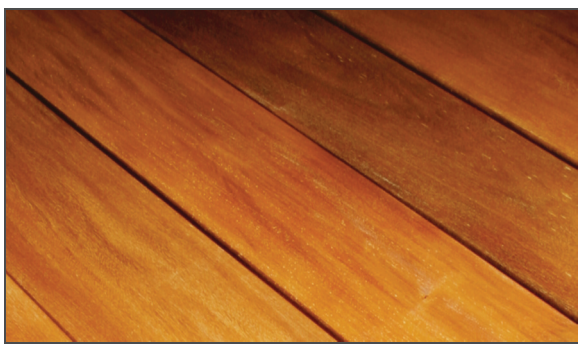

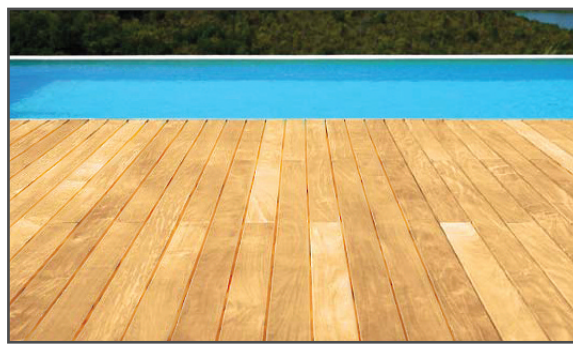
